A helpful acronym for what to do during vestry formation is VHS - Vision, Huddle, and Skill. Vision concerns the "big picture" of what the church is about. Huddle is the time for sharing, either personal sharing, or "good news" stories of what God is doing in the parish through Evening Prayer, devotions, or Eucharist.
