Pollinated bees fly into beehives and start working for a while. When done, they exit the hive, increasing the honey level by 1. When the honey level has reached 5, the block's appearance changes, indicating that it is full of honey, and produces dripping honey particles if suspended above the ground. If shears are used on a full beehive, it drops three honeycombs.

Frames and Foundations For a basic beehive, assemble two brood chambers that are 9 and 5/8 inches deep and two supers that are 6 and 5/8 inches deep. Make these boxes four-sided with no bottoms or tops. Place a queen excluder between the upper brood chamber hive body and the lower super hive body.

Start by taking your roof plywood (500mm x 420mm) and cut it in half, so you have two pieces 500mm x 210mm. Now cut pieces of plank for the sides, 350mm x 12mm (13 3/4" x 4 3/4"). Next, cut a ridge piece 500mm x 60mm (19 3/4" x 2 1/2"), and two gable ends 390mm x 210mm (15 1/2" x 8 1/4").

A langstroth beehive has three super (beehive box) sizes, deep, medium, and shallow. The basic beehive has two types of supers. A brood super, this is where the queen and growing colony resides, and a honey super, this is where the bees make their honey.
