There are two pathways to obtain the BAS degree in Interpreting & Sign Language Studies: 1) A 2+2 pathway in which students complete an Associates of Applied Science in Interpreting & Sign Language from another institution and then transfer to MSU to complete years 3 and 4, resulting in a BAS in Interpreting & Sign Language Studies, or 2) Beginning the BAS degree and completing all four years at MSU.

Sign language interpreting research has shown that the optimum processing time to produce a quality piece of interpretation is approximately 20-30 minutes (Gabrian & Williams, 2009) and then after that the interpreter's stress levels increase, fatigue kicks in and the quality of the interpretation starts to deteriorate.
