We become what we worship. That is to say, we emulate—or become like—the people (and things) we most admire. To understand this concept, we have to understand the origins of the word worship. The word worship comes from the Old English *worðscip* or *wurðscip* —or *worþship*—meaning "condition of being worthy, dignity, glory, distinction, honor, renown."
